Thursday June 22nd

This day was good weather see a steamer going south so ends this day

lat 8° 28' S lon 11° 43' E

Friday June 23^d

The first part of this day was calm the latter part wind breezed up so we head south on starboard tack bjer repairing water but loward for Black fish waist Boat got two small fish so ends

lat 8° 38' S lon 11° 49' E

Saturday June 24th

This day was moderate weather Sparrows to west ward by the wind with all sail out

lat 9° 09' S lon 12° 04' E

Sunday June 25th

This day was pleasant weather loward for Black fish loward Boat struck one so ends this day

lat 8° 40' S lon 11° 18' E

Monday June 26

This day pleasant breeze spoke schr agate bark resounding star in sight so ends the cook takes sick with

cramps inwardly and is released from duty and sent below for medical treatment which he receives from capt.

Tuesday June 27th

This day was pleasant weather agate in sight see a bark to loward at sunset taken ship heading to south east

lat 8° 38' S lon 9° 18' E

Wednesday June 28th

This day was pleasant weather schr agate in sight off the weather beam and other sail in sight off lee beam the cook is still lingering so ends this day

Thursday June 29th

This day was pleasant weather see breaches and fin backs schr agate in sight the cook still sick so ends this day

lat 9° 33' S lon 10° 20' E

Friday June 30th

This day moderate weather spoke schr agate see breaches early in the morning and run for them but see nothing in

lat 9° 37' S lon 10° 57' E
