Saturday July 15th

This day was pleasant weather at sun set took in sail heading S south east two sick men is on the men Mr Antonio Desantos a sailor broke the rules of the ship and was put in irons for disobedience by telling the mate he would not work he was kept in irons for half an hour and then released lat 10.53 S lon 7.28 E

Antonio Desantos was after words set to work by the captain. He refused to work under a law but after he thought they were not worth the trouble he was released.

Sunday July 16th

This day was moderate with thick atmosphere heading east south east at night took in sail the two men that was sick is on the men Medical treat ment is stop as its not necessary to extend it any farther Mr Antonio Desantos was released from work to day as it was Sunday lat 10.59 S lon 8.05 E

Monday July 17th

This day good weather see black fish John comaker goes to duty Antonio Desantos is kept on deck

This day was good weather stirring east all day see pump backs at night took in sail John Gifford the cook is not on duty but he is round decks Antonio Desantos was given this watch below lat 10.48 S lon 9.46 E

Wednesday July 19th

This day good weather spoke Bark Bertha lat 10.30 S lon 10.02 E

Thursday July 20

This day good weather Bark Bertha in sight toward for black fish barboard Boat struck one so ends

Friday July 21st

This day pleasant weather spoke Bark Bertha John C. Gifford is round decks but not on duty lat 10.10 S lon 10.20 E

Saturday July 22nd

This day was pleasant weather Bark Bertha in sight so ends this day lat 10.12 S lon 9.59 E
