Sunday July 23<sup>rd</sup>

This day was moderate weather Bark Bertha in sight of lee beam about four miles off we are steering to the westward by the wind four top gallant sail furled lat 10.32 S lon 10.30 E

Monday July 24<sup>th</sup>

This day was pleasant weather Bark Bertha in sight of lee beam about eight miles off lat 10.29 S lon 9.36 E

Tuesday July 25<sup>th</sup>

This day was calm weather Bark Bertha in sight John C. Gifford the cooper goes to duty on his own record but was not called to duty by neither capt or mate lat 10.29 S lon 9.36 E

Wednesday July 26

This day good weather spoke Bark Bertha lat 10.43 S lon 9.43 E

Thursday July 27<sup>th</sup>

This day moderate spoke Bark Bertha lat 11.16 S lon 9.55 E

This day was moderate toward for hump backs but did not strike the Bertha is off lee beam she also humped and pulled up thinking it was sperm whales so ended

Sunday July 30<sup>th</sup>

This day was moderate weather toward for black fish larger boat got one fish waist boat got four pieces Bark Bertha in sight lat 10.47 S lon 9.46 E

Monday July 31<sup>st</sup>

This day was quite fresh breeze from south steering to westward by the wind Bertha in sight off lee beam took in main and fore top gallant sails and got top sail lat 11.09 S lon 7.24 E
