Thursday December 10<sup>th</sup> Lat 00.48<sup>S</sup> Lon 27.59<sup>W</sup>  
 This day fine weather all sail  
 set by the wind on Port tack heading  
 to the S. W. by S. one sail in sight

Friday December 11<sup>th</sup> Lat 2.30<sup>S</sup> Lon 29.28<sup>W</sup>  
 This day strong breeze from  
 the S. E. all sail set by the wind  
 on Port tack heading to the S. W.  
 one sail in sight to the N. W.

Saturday December 12<sup>th</sup> no obs  
 This day fine weather all sail  
 set by the wind on Port tack heading  
 to the S. W. one sail in sight

Sunday December 13<sup>th</sup> no obs  
 This day fine weather all sail  
 set by the wind on Port tack heading  
 to the S. W. several sails in sight

Monday December 14<sup>th</sup> no obs  
 This day strong breeze from the  
 S. E. all sail set by the wind on Port tack  
 heading to the S. W.

 set by the wind on Port tack heading  
 to the S. Compared Longitude with  
 American Barkentine

Thursday December 17<sup>th</sup> Lat 14.05<sup>S</sup> Lon 34.22<sup>W</sup>  
 This day strong breeze all sail  
 set by the wind on Port tack heading  
 to the S. S. W. at 5.30 P. M. raise  
 blackfish hord four boats got none

Friday December 18<sup>th</sup> Lat 16.20<sup>S</sup> Lon 35.01<sup>W</sup>  
 This day strong breeze from  
 the S. E. ship under topsails and courses  
 heading to the S. S. W.

Saturday December 19<sup>th</sup> Lat 19.34 Lon 35.11  
 First part of this day strong  
 breeze latter part squally Compared  
 Longitude with a English Bark  
 bound north
