- Monday January 11th Lat 36.36 Lon 18.05 W
This day light wind from the N. all sail set steering E by S 1/2 S saw two sails bound S.E.
- Tuesday January 12th Lat 36.44 Lon 12.40
First part of this day fine weather wind from the N. W. all sail set steering S.E. latter part squally at 5.00 P.M. raise Tristan Islands a head 30 miles off
- Wednesday January 13th Lat 37.03 Lon 11.56
This day light wind from the N. W. all day light Tristan bore E 30 miles, steered for the land at 8.00 P.M. a boat from shore came alongside with trades
- Thursday January 14th Lat 37.01 Lon 11.38
off Tristan this day fine weather wind from the N. at 6.00 P.M. steered to the S.E.
- Friday January 15th Lat 37.24 Lon 9.48
This day strong breeze from the N ship under topsails and foresail steering to the S.E.

- Saturday January 16th Lat 37.00 Lon 7.44 W
This day strong breeze from the N ship under lower topsails and foresail steering to the E
- Sunday January 17th Lat 36.12 Lon 6.50
This day strong breeze from the N. W. ship under lower topsails and foresail by the wind on Port tack heading N.E. at 6.00 P.M. went round heading W
- Monday January 18th Lat 35.42 Lon 6.46
First part of this day strong breeze at 6.00 A.M. went round on Port tack latter part moderate with whole topsails
- Tuesday January 19th Lat 34.21 Lon 7.32
This day strong breeze from the S. W. ship under topsails and courses steering to the N. W.
- Wednesday January 20th Lat 33.54 Lon 8.10
This day light wind and calm steering N. W. by N. saw several porpoise
- Thursday January 21th Lat 33.52 Lon 8.22
First part of this day calm latter light wind from the E. at 10 A.M. raise a large sperm whale going N. W. lured four boats L.B. struck got whale to ship at 5.00 P.M.
