this day begins with clear and pleasant weather from the S.E. steering N. by W with all sail set and the watch employed ship duty at 8 P.M. got one popose so ends this day.

this day begins with clear weather from S.E. steering N. by W with all sail set. This day nothing doing so ends.

this day begins with clear and pleasant weather from S.E. steering N. by W at day light took up water after each side tane the boats right & left up at 8:30 A.M. took the foresail down to be repair, the mate and the watch employed repair. but not finished, one sail in sight so ends this day.

Tuesday June 8: 18:97
this day begins with fine weather from S.E. steering N. by W with all sail set at day light began on foresail at 3 P.M. fine clear. Latter part the same 2 sails in sight so ends.
