at 5:30 A.M. Called all hands
and began to Cut at 11:30 A.M.
finished Cutting at 2 P.M. stor-
ed the Works and the rest Em-
ployed in the heads and Cutting
up the blubber so ends this day

Lat 30-19

Long 43-22

Thursday July 1: 18:97
this day begins with clear and
Pleasant weather from S.E. Steer-
ing W. by N. and all hands Em-
ployed holing and stowing
some the oil down at noon
got up tackle and got out
Water and Pork at 4 P.M. fi-
nished holing so ends.

Lat 30:25 Long 41:05

Friday July 2: 18:97
this day begins with fine
weather from S.E. at day light
got up tackle and the watch Em-
ployed stowing down the rest
of the oil at 4 P.M. finished
and Washed of decks, one sail
in sight so ends this day.

Lat 30-07 Long 39-00

Saturday July 3: 18:97
this day begins with light
winds and calm steering W. by
N. with all sail set and the
watch employed ship duty
at 2 P.M. killed the Pig at
5 P.M. sighted 3 smaller mackerel
and latter part the same so ends.

Sunday July 4: 18:97
this day begins with light breeze
from S.W. heading W. by N. with
all sail set at 11 A.M. saw 3 sperm
whales going quick to windward
at noon lowered 2 boats W. Boat
and L. Boat at 2 P.M. L. Boat
went on and fasten with sail
no chance and the iron dring
and lost the whale at 8 P.M. got
lost and hoisted the boats so ends.

Lat 30-10 Long 46:35

Monday July 5: 18:97
this day begins with light breeze
and Pleasant weather from S.W.
heading by the wind W. by N. at
7-30 A.M. saw 3 sperm whales 3
miles off going quick to Northward
at 9 A.M. lowered 3 boats S. Boat
struck and save the whale at noon
got the whale to the ship at 1:30
P.M. lowered 2 boats for the same
whales but did not get near them
at 5 P.M. came on board got soap
and got up Cutting gear at 7 P.M.
set the watch so ends this day.

Lat 30-06

Long 47-13

Tuesday July 6: 18:97
this day begins with light wind
at day light saw 3 sperm whales
at 5 A.M. lowered 3 boats L. Boat
struck and save the whale at
noon got the whale to the ship
and began to Cut at 1 P.M.
saw 3 sperm whales and lowered
3 boats and struck 3 one S.B.
one L.B. and one W. Boat
