up to 10 A.M. and getting ready to
boil so ends.

Friday July 23:18:99
this day begins with light
breeze and Calms heading by the
wind E. by S. with Indian top
gallant sail set at 8: A.M. Coaled all
hands and got brackpist at 8:30
beginning to put some the oil
down below at 6 P.M. had 50
bbls down and rock up and
got so per and set the watch
this day got out two lusses and
1/2 bbls stuff so ends
