Saturday July 24th 1897
 This day begins with light breeze from S.W. heading by the wind S. S. E. at 8 A.M. began to put the rest of the oil below at 5 P.M. finished and washed of decks and wore ship to N.E. 3 sails in sight so ends this day.

Sunday July 25th 1897
 This day begins with light breeze from S.W. heading by the wind E. by S. with fore and main galls to sail set at 6 P.M. spoke the E. B. Cornwall Schooner and the Captain came on board so ends

Monday July 26th 1897
 This day begins with light breeze and Calms at 8 A.M. Capt Enos went on board E. B. Cornwall at 1 P.M. came on board with Capt Avery and he stayed on board to 9 P.M. so ends this day.
 Lat 31-06 Long 51-33

Tuesday July 27th 1897
 This day begins with light breeze from W. N.W. steering E. N. E. at 8 A.M. saw E. B. Cornwall tacking whale at 8 A.M. got up tackle and brock out Bread and Flour and some shoes and Cooper Employed

sitting up them at 6 P.M. Capt Enos went on board the Cone well at 6:30 P.M. saw Steamer at 7 took in all the light sails and the topsails so ends this day.

Wednesday July 28th 1897
 This day begins with fine breeze from the Westward steering N. E. by E. at day light made all sail at 6:30 A.M. saw something supposed to be sperm whales 3 miles off going quick in to Eastward at 7:30 A.M. lost sight then after brock fist Cooper and the watch employed sitting up shoos middle and latter part the same at sundown took in all the sail but fore and main lower topsail and wore ship and headed N. N.W. at day light saw Schooner bound to North so ends this day.
 Lat 31-25 Long 50-23

Thursday July 29th 1897
 This day begins with fine breeze from W. N.W. heading by the wind North at day light made all sail at noon got up tackle and got out one bill of Pork and stored the Casps Cooper flize at sundown took in all the sail but fore and main lower topsail at 3:30 P.M. the breeze fell overboard lost the tacking on board aging middle and latter part the same so ends.
