Friday July 30th 1897
 This day begins with strong wind
 and heavy seas from W. N. W. at
 day light set fore and main topsail
 and foresail and jib heading by
 the wind N. by W. at 8 A.M.
 wore ship to Southward heading
 S. W. by S. and the watch com
 pleted ships duty at 7 P.M.
 started Cook Bells at
 sundown took in sail but 2
 low topsails so ends

Saturday July 31st 97
 This day begins with clear
 and pleasant weather from N.W.
 heading by the wind W. S. W. at
 day light made all sail and
 at 1 P.M. in the watch employed
 bracing Watter and Sugar
 at 3 P.M. finished at 4 P.M.
 Washed of decks, at sundown
 took in sail heading the same
 so ends this day with 3 sails
 in sight.

Sunday August 1st 97
 This day begins with calm
 and light breeze from the North
 heading by the wind W. N. W.
 at 4:30 P.M. wore ship and
 headed by the wind E. N. E. at
 sundown took in all the sail
 but the two lower topsails
 so ends this day

 This day begins with calm all day
 at 7 A.M. took down the hoop fore
 topsail and the mate and the watch com
 pleted repairing at 3 P.M. finished
 and sent up at 4 P.M. washed of
 decks middle and latter part the

Tuesday August 3rd 1897
 This day begins with light breeze
 from S. E. steering N. by E with
 all sail set at 8 A.M. got out
 Watter and the rest of day com
 pleted ships duty so ends one sail
 in sight at sundown took in all
 sail but fore and main lower
 topsail

Wednesday August 4th 97
 This day begins with calm at
 day light the watch employed
 washing the ship outside, middle
 and latter part the same one sail
 and one steamers in sight so ends
 No Obs.

Thursday August 5th 97
 This day begins with little
 more wind from N. N. W.
 heading by the wind N. E. by N.
 with all sail set one sail in
 sight, and the watch employed
 ships duty so ends this day.
