This day begins with Clear and
Pleasant weather from the North
heading by the wind E. N.E. at day
light made all sail after brack
fist wore ship heading W. N.W.
and got up jackle and brock out
main hache to fire Cashe oil
to warleking and pompat out
at 11 P.M. finche the rest
of the day employed ships
duty at sundown took in all
the sail but the two lower
topsail and fore and Mizen
staysail, and this day hute
one reef in Mizen staysail
to be hure en galle of wind
so Ends this day.

and Calm at day light made all sail
heading by the wind N.E. middle
and latter part the same, the wat
ch employed ships duty at 5 P.M.

the two lower topsails so Ends.
