Tuesday Oct. 19: 18: 97

This day begins with strong winds from the E. eastward heading by the wind S. E. at 7:30 A. M. wore ship to North heading N. N. E. set main topsail Tib and Spanck at 2 P. M. heavy rain and wind squally from E. took in main top sail Tib and Spanck and set mainsail heading E. N. E. latter part rainy so ends.

Wednesday Oct. 20: 18: 97

This day begins with fresh breeze from S. N. E. heading E. S. E. after brack fiste set foresail and main sail and fore and main top sail and all the light sails middle and latter part more moderated winds from S. S. W. steering E. at sundown took in main sail and upper fore topsail and all the light sails so ends this day.

Thursday Oct. 21: 18: 97

This day begins with light wind from W. W. steering E. N. E. at day light set fore top sail and main gallante sail steering N. E. middle part the wind all to N. E. heading by the wind E. S. E. at day light got up tackle and brack velt Water Beef and Bread and foley game. Put water at 5 P. M. finished at sundown took in

This day begins with fresh winds and heavy weather from E. N. E. heading by the wind N. by E. at 7 A. M. set main sail and all the light sails steering North by E. & E. middle and latter part strong winds from the E. eastward at 6 P. M. took in all the light sails. one of the 4 sick Men on duty by the name Manucha boy and the 3 still very sick the medicine that was put up by the doctor in St. Helena for belly Borey has bin given them A Cordin to directory so ends this day. saw Steamer to day bound South.

This day begins with strong and heavy gale from E. N. E. heading by the wind North with two lower top sails and foresail. at 10:30 P.
