Wednesday November 3: 1897
 This day begins with fresh breezes
 from S.E. at 1 P.M. saw Point Ledge
 light, buff to the wind till morning
 at day light steered of N.N.E.
 at 11:30 P.M. took a Pilot at
 Block Island: at the same time
 one of the sick men died by the
 name Antonio Alves. at 8 P.M.
 employed getting the Anchors
 of the Bow steering S.E. N.E. with
 full sail set at 5 P.M. the wind
 all to N.W. at 6 P.M. took New
 Bedford Pilot steering N.N.E.
 the state of the sick men better
 better to day at 9 P.M. Anchored
 of Clocks Point so ends this day;

Thursday November 4: 1897
 This day begins with clear and Plea-
 sant weather from N.W. being at Anchor
 waiting for the doctor and the tug
