26 Monday This day a strong breeze from the E with light passing squalls the barque steering S under all sail employed in breaking out shooks and doing other jobs so ends this day

28 Wednesday this day a strong breeze the first part the barque steering S under short sail the middle and latter a light breeze from the N.E. the barque steering S under all sail employed in setting up cask so ends this day 1 sail in sight

29 Thursday this day commenced with a light breeze the first part from the S.E. the middle and latter a strong breeze from the N.E. the barque steering S under short sail employed in flaying cask and stowing the hold 4 sails in sight so ends this day

30 Friday this day a strong breeze from the N.E. the barque steering S by W under short sail employed in stowing down empty cask and got through at 4 P.M. so ends this day

1 Saturday this day commenced with a light breeze from the N.E. the barque steering S.W. under all sail employed in washing ship and doing other jobs so ends this day

2 Sunday this day a light breeze from the N.E. the barque steering S.W. and saw the Island Saint Anton at 4.30 P.M. a boat 40 miles distant at dark bore a boat S.W. by S and came to anchor at noon so ends this day

3 Monday this day employed unbenching and banding sails so ends this day

4 Tuesday we are still laying at anchor at St Anton employed in breaking out the hold and pumping salt water out of the cask and doing other jobs so ends this day

5 Wednesday still laying in St Anton employed in taking water and four men ran a way so ends this day

6 Thursday this day finish stowing the hold and took the anchor and stow away the chain and one came back this morning so ends this day

7 Friday this day a strong breeze from the N.E. the barque steer S.W. the first part under short sail the middle and latter light passing rain squalls from the E the latter calm employed in ships duty so ends this day
