to take the anchor to go to St Kitts
we took the anchor at 10 AM and
made all sail so ends this day

12 Wednesday we came to anchor at
St Kitts at 8 AM and started painting
ship so ends this day

13 Thursday we took the anchor from
St Kitts and anchor at St. Christopher
at 6 PM and also the Captains wife
on board the Steamer to go home
so ends this day
