- 15 Thursday this day a light breeze the barque lying too with 3 whales along side and at 5 A.M. commenced cutting and got through at noon and still boiling so ends this day
2 men sick

- 16 Friday this day a light breeze from the W the barque is lying too employed in boiling and cutting up the heads and pumping waste and storing down oil so ends this day 2 men sick

- 17 Saturday this day a light breeze from the S.E. the barque cruising under short sail employed in boiling and storing down oil and stow 10 gals so ends this day one Steamer in sight 2 men sick

- 18 Sunday this day a light breeze from the S the barque cruising under all sail and saw a dead whale all decay so ends this day 2 men sick

- 19 Monday this day a light breeze from the S.E. the barque cruising under all sail employed in making one cask and broke out flour and nothing in sight 2 men sick so ends this day

- 20 Tuesday this day a light breeze from the S the barque cruising under all sail employed in flaying one cask and pick up a plank and doing other jobs and nothing in sight so ends this day 2 men sick

- 21 Wednesday this day a light breeze from the W the barque cruising under all sail employed in making a galley mast and saw Blackfish and dove 3 boats but without success came on board so ends this day

- 22 Thursday this day a light breeze from the W the barque cruising under all sail employed in repairing the S.B. and put her over head and saw a Silver Bottom so ends this day and pick up yellow pine timber 20 ft long Lat 33.34 N

- 23 Friday this day a light breeze from the W the barque cruising under all sail employed in ship's duty also pick up a yellow pine plank 22 feet long 9 in wide 3 inches thick two Steamers in sight so ends this day

- 25 Sunday this day a light breeze from the N.E. the barque cruising under short sail the middle and latter squaring and raising ran the two Steamers and pick up a yellow pine timber 31 ft long and 14 by 15 square so ends this day 2 men are still sick and of duty
