8 Saturday this day a light breeze from the N.E. the barque cruising under all sail 2 men sick so ends this day

9 Sunday this day a light breeze from the E the barque cruising under short sail saw one Schooner with the Captain sick hauled to the Weston Island and nothing more in sight but two men sick and of duty so ends this day

 10 Monday this day a light breeze from the S.E. the barque cruising under all sail and raised a school of whales and dove 3 boats and 4 whalers along side and the J.B. chase of and struck at dark so ends this day

11 Tuesday this day a light breeze from the S.E. the barque laying too and took the J.B. at 11 P.M. the latter commenced cutting and got through at noon so ends this day one sail in sight and 2 men sick
 so ends

12 Wednesday this day a light breeze from the E the barque laying too employed in boiling and clearing the heads and broke the Pedro Verreller with 3.30 this season 2 men sick and of duty so ends this day

13 Thursday this day a light breeze from the E the barque cruising under short sail employed in boiling and got through boiling at 3 P.M. and stow down 84 bbls. and raised a school of whales and dove 3 boats and the Pedro Verreller dove 3 boats but with out success so ends this day

14 Friday this day a light breeze from the S.W. the barque cruising and raised whaler at 6 A.M. and dove 3 boats at 7 A.M. and met the Schooner the Schooner got one and the Bark got one and Schooner boat got stone so ends this day
