- 15 Friday this day employed in taking water and stowing the hold and had a cooper from shore so ends this day and send down the Gallant gear
- 16 Saturday this day employed in taking water and stowing the hold and had the cooper for a few hours so ends this day
- 17 Sunday this day one watch on shore so ends this day and at dark the cutter boat came and took on a fight and the cutter boat came and took on
- 18 Monday employed in taking water and painting ship so ends this day
- 19 Tuesday this day employed in taking water and painting ship and doing other jobs so ends this day

- 20 Wednesday this day employed in taking water and finish stowing the hold and painting ship so ends this day
- 21 Thursday this day employed in painting the boat and doing other jobs so ends this day
- 22 Friday this day employed in painting and doing other jobs so ends this day also discharge Martin Brett sick
- 23 Saturday this day employed in packing bread and stow away the old sails and had two men from shore to saw the timber in boards what we pick up so ends this day
- 24 Sunday this day one watch on shore also the Berther came in with 550 lbs so ends day
- 25 Monday this day employed in stowing sails and doing other jobs and the Captain wife came so ends this day
- 26 Tuesday this day employed in setting up head gear and doing other jobs so ends this day also
- 27 Wednesday employed in taking Potatoes and the Pedro Vidua & Joseph A. Nanton sail so ends this day
- 28 Thursday employed in sending up the yards and doing other jobs
