

September 1899

- 29 Friday employ in ships duty and all ready for sea so ends this day
- 30 Saturday this day employed in ships duty and the A. R. Tucker & Sunbeam gone out so ends this day

October

- 1 Sunday this day one watch on shore and a strong breeze from the N.E. so ends this day
- 2 Monday this day employed in taking records and the Sunbeam sail for good so ends this day
- 3 Tuesday this day blowing a gale so that we could not get out so ends this day
- 4 Wednesday this day blowing strong with a little rain from the N.E. we had the Royals and one Steamer came in so ends this day
- 5 Thursday this day employed in ships duty the Canton try to get out but could not go on account of bad weather so ends this day
- 6 Friday this day employed in sending down the Gallant yards & Royal yards and blowing a gale and plenty of rain so ends this day
- 7 Saturday this day blowing strong employed in ships duty so ends this day
- 8 Sunday this day the same so ends this day

October

- 9 Monday this day fine weather we still lay in Bagal employed in ships duty so ends this day
- 10 Tuesday this day fine weather the Canton & Bladine went out but fell heavy rain from the S.W. so ends this day
- 11 Wednesday this day fine weather employed in sending the Ponce shore and doing other jobs so ends this day
- 12 Thursday we took the anchor from Bagal in the morn the tow boat tow us out and returns back and the tide took the barge in on the shore and she struck her quarter on the rock and then she came up with a little damage the boat had leave the ship when she struck she struck about 11 A.M. and the tide took her off again so ends this day and three men stow away
- 13 Friday this day we had to get the tow boat to tow us up and tow fish boats so we went on board again and made sail the Captain let go the ducker and 45 fathoms of chain and then it spun up a little breeze from the N.W. the barge steer S.W. under all sail the latter the same so ends this day
- 14 Saturday this day a good breeze from the N.W. the barge steering S under all sail employed in breaking out flour and sugar so ends this day
