24 Tuesday this day a strong breeze from the N.E. the barque steering S.S.W. until dark then shorten sail and kept by the wind on the Port tack the middle a strong breeze the latter cruising under short sail employed in ship's duty so ends this day

25 Wednesday this day a light breeze from the N.E. the barque cruising under short sail employed making a boat mast and doing other jobs so ends this day

26 Thursday this day a light breeze from the N.E. the barque cruising and at dark kept to with the foreyard a back the latter cruising under short sail employed in making a dinner and two Steamers in sight so ends this day

27 Friday this a light breeze from the N.E. the barque cruising under short sail the middle and latter Steer S.W. by W under short sail employed in putting out the B.B. David and broke out Beef so ends Thursday

28 Saturday this day a light breeze from the N.E. the barque steering S.S.W. under short sail and raised the Islands of St. Anthony and two Steamers employed in painting the David so ends this day

29 Sunday this day a light breeze from the N.E. the barque steering S.W. by S under short sail the Island of St. Anthony bear W by S about 4 1/2 miles of at dark we lay a back until daylight and steer for St. Vincent the Captain and Wife went ashore and 2 men and stay for the night so ends this day

30 Monday this day a strong breeze from the N.E. the barque laying off and on at St. Vincent all night and all day the Captain are still on shore so ends this day

31 Tuesday this day a strong breeze the barque laying off and on at St. Vincent the Captain and Wife came on board at 6 PM and steer for St. Lucia and beat all day so ends this day

November

1 Wednesday we came to anchor at 7.30 P.M. at St. Lucia the latter repairing the stern and break out water and two boats went a fishing so ends this day

2 Thursday this day strong breeze and rain employed in sailing down the Mizzen topmast and repairing the quarter and rearing boats Luke falls so ends this day

3 Friday this day employed in putting out the B.B. and repairing the stern and doing other odd jobs so ends this day
