- 4 Saturday the barque laying to anchor at St Lucia employed in putting out the B.B. fly board and finish the stern and the Captain send the L.B. with the third to St Vincent so ends this day Second mate sick and of duty
- 5 Sunday the barque laying to anchor at St Lucia the Second mate sick and of duty and one man in irons so ends this day
- 6 Monday this day employed in setting up the mezzoon reigon and doing other jobs also the Second mate sick and one man in irons so ends this day
- 7 Tuesday this day employed in mending sails and broke out flour and sugar and the Second mate sick and of duty and one man in irons so ends this day
- 8 Wednesday this day employed in mending sails and doing other jobs Second mate sick and of duty and took the man out of irons so ends this day
- 9 Thursday this day employed in breaking out a new cask of Beef 6 1/2 lbs and doing other jobs so ends this day
- 10 Friday this day employed in ships duty and still laying the anchor at St ~~Vincent~~ Lucia so ends this day

- 11 Saturday this day a light breeze from the E we took the anchor from St ~~Lucia~~ at 6 A.M. the Capt is worst and started for St Vincent but a light wind and strong tide we could not get there so ends this day
- 12 Sunday this day a light breeze from the N.E. the barque heaving for St Vincent the Captain is worst we got to St Vincent at 9 A.M. the Captain and wife gone ashore and one seaman deserted so ends this day and ship two seamen
- 13 Monday this day a light breeze from the N.E. the barque laying off and on at St Vincent and the mate in charge she is going to cruise for ten or fifteen days and then return to St Vincent so ends this day

- 14 Tuesday this day a light breeze from the N.E. the barque cruising off St Antonio employed in repairing the foretop gallant sail so ends this day

- 15 Wednesday this day a light breeze from the N.E. the barque cruising under all sail of St Antonio and the Island in sight one sail in sight employed in making a boat sail and doing other jobs so ends this day
