- 1 Friday this day a very light air from the S the first part the middle and latter part employed in breaking out 1 bbl of Beef and still laying of and on at St Vincent and a few Steamers in sight so ends this day
- 2 Saturday this day commenced with a calm the middle and latter a light breeze from the W and the S to the Island a boat 10 miles of and we are still laying of and on employed in ships duty so ends this day
- 3 Sunday this day a light breeze from the S & the first part the middle and latter calm the Islands are in sight so ends this day
- 4 Monday this day a light breeze from the S & the barque laying of and on at St Vincent employed in ships duty so ends this day
- 5 Tuesday this day a light breeze from the N & the barque laying of and on at St Vincent and the mate sent the boat ashore employed in ships duty so ends this day the Captain had ship 2 seamen Antonio Selvira Antonio of Silva
- 6 Wednesday this day a light breeze from the N & the first part the middle and latter a strong breeze the barque laying of and on the boat got back from St Vincent at 8 P.M. and the Captain was a little better employed in breaking out water and doing other jobs 5 Steamers in sight and one Schooner so ends this day

- 7 Thursday this day a strong breeze from the N & the barque laying of and on at St Vincent and the boat went on shore but no Swallow get employed in breaking out Flora and doing other jobs so ends this day
- 8 Friday this day a light breeze from the N & the barque laying of and on at St Vincent employed in getting the Archer of ready and half rep the cable so ends this day
- 9 Saturday this day a light breeze from the N & the barque beating up to the Port and we got up this at 2 P.M. the Captain came on board and the Mate took his discharge and Mr Peter is in charge so ends this day
- 10 Sunday this day a light breeze from the N & the middle and latter a strong the barque laying of and on at St Vincent a few Steamers in sight so ends this day
- 11 Monday this day a light breeze from the N & the first part the middle and latter a strong breeze the barque laying of and on at St Vincent employed in breaking out Tea and Beans and 4000 tins so ends this day and made new gib plinths
- 12 Tuesday this day a strong breeze from the N & the middle and latter the same employed in breaking out one barrel of Beef and the barque still laying of and on at St Vincent so ends this day
