26 Tuesday this day commenced with a warm employed in breaking out one barrel of Beef and a little meat and doing other jobs so ends this day

27 Wednesday this day a light breeze from the N.W. the barque steering by the wind under all sail employed in pecking over potatoes and the Island at Saul in sight so ends this day

28 Thursday this day a light breeze from the E the barque cruising under all sail employed in ship's duty and saw one school of Blackfish so ends this day

29 Friday this day a light breeze from the N.E. the barque cruising under all sail and spoke the Pedro Varela with 180 lbs. so ends this day

30 Saturday this day a light breeze from the N.E. the barque cruising under all sail employed in setting up main topmast reizen and 2 Steamers & 1 Schooner in sight so ends this day

31 Sunday this day a light breeze from the N.E. the first part the middle and latter a strong breeze and a heavy squall from the N.E. and the Schooner in sight so ends this day and this year

1 Monday this day a strong breeze from the N.E. the barque cruising under short sail and spoke the Pedro Varela so ends this day

2 Tuesday this day a strong breeze from E the barque cruising under short sail employed in making Flygile sheets and doing other jobs and the Schooner in sight so ends this day

Lat Long
3 Wednesday this day a strong breeze from the E the barque and the Pedro Varela started for St Nicholas and raised it about 11 A.M. and star for it at dark it was about 12 miles of so ends this day

Lat Long
4 Thursday this day a light breeze from the N.E. the barque steering for St Nicholas and came to and anchor at 11 A.M. also the Schooner employed in sending down the Rigging yards and setting up the rigging and the Captain went ashore so ends this day

5 Friday this day the barque laying so anchor at St Nicholas employed in setting up rigging and also the Schooner so ends this day and broke out Flour

6 Saturday this day employed in setting up rigging and got through and broke out a new cask of Beef 131 gal 4 & and he did some treading for recruits and pigs and the Schooner are here too so ends this day and seven men deserted
