- 16 Monday this day a strong breeze and squally the barque steering W by N half N under all sail employed in opening a new cask of Bread gudge of cask 362 and setting up cask so ends this day

- 17 Tuesday this day a light breeze and squally from the E the barque steering W by N & N under all sail employed in setting up cask and doing other jobs so ends this day

- 18 Wednesday this day a strong breeze from the E. N. E the barque steering W by N & N under all sail employed in ship's duty and saw the Island of Martinick so ends this day

- 19 Thursday this day a strong breeze the barque steering for the Island of Dominica and came to anchor at 9 AM so ends this day

- 20 Friday this day employed in mashing ship and breaking out and pumping salt water and taking fresh water and heading so ends this day

- 21 Saturday this day a strong breeze employed in taking water and heading so ends this day

- 22 Sunday a strong breeze the whatch on shore and the A. R. Tucker came to anchor at Dominica so ends this day

- 23 Monday this day a do odd jobs and took two boat loads of stone so ends this day and the Captain went to Roser

- 24 Tuesday this day doing odd jobs and broke out sugar and the Captain have not return from Roser so ends this day

- 25 Wednesday this day employed in painting ship and one whatch on liberty

- 26 Thursday this day employed in painting ship and one whatch on liberty

- 27 Friday this day employed in taking one boat load of wood and two cask of water and painting ship so ends this day

- 28 Saturday this day employed in painting ship and got through also the captain return from Roser at dark so ends this day

- 29 Sunday one whatch on shore and the A. R. Tucker sail for St Kitts so ends this day

- 30 Monday employed in breaking out oil and setting up cask so ends this day

May

- 1 Tuesday employed in taking water and setting up cask and stowing the hold and the Schooner E. B. Connel came to anchor
