- 2 Wednesday employed in setting up cask and taking water also the Captain return from Rover so ends this day
- 3 Thursday employed in taking water and setting up cask and stowing the hold and the Adeline Chase came to anchor so ends this day
- 4 Friday employed in taking water and setting up cask and stowing the hold so ends this day
- 5 Saturday employed in taking wood and stowing the hold and took a little water so ends this day
- 6 Sunday this one watch on shore and a little rain so ends this day
- 7 Monday this day employed in shipping oil on board the Comtishell and ship 200.21 gal so ends this day
- 8 Tuesday this day employed in taking the Anchor from Dominica at 2 P.M. so ends this day 1 Seaman deserted
- 9 Wednesday this day we are sailing for St Kitts and came to anchor at 9 A.M. and took Molasses and 2 Steamers can - in so ends this day
- 10 Thursday this day employed in taking stores at St Kitts and all hands had a run on shore and took the Anchor at 2.30 P.M. and Anchor at Gustatus at 6.20 so ends this day

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- 11 Friday employed in painting the boats and washing ship so ends this day Mate sick and of duty and one man
- 12 Saturday employed in painting ship in side and the A R Tucker sail so ends this day and ship 10 Seamen and ship 2 boat steers and one boy
- 13 Sunday this day we are getting ready for sea so ends this day Mate and 1 man sick and of duty
- 14 Monday this day employed in taking the Anchor from Gustatus at 2 P.M. and stowing away the chane and doing other jobs so ends this day Mate and 3 men sick Lat
- 15 Tuesday Long this day a strong breeze from the E the barge steering by the wind on the Starboard tack under short sail employed in ships duty the Mate and 1 Seaman and 2 Boat steers sick and of duty and the ship sprung a leak so ends this day Lat
- 16 Wednesday this day a good breeze from the S.E. the barge steering N.W.E. under all sail employed in sailing over the G.B. and doing other jobs saw one Steamer in sight the Mate and 4 men sick and of duty so ends this day Lat
- 17 Thursday this day a light breeze from the S.E. the barge steering by the wind under short sail employed in coaking the mureless and painting the boats David the Mate on duty and one man so ends this day Lat Long
