

4 Monday ^{from} this day employed in cutting in and out of blubber and starting boiling the latter took in the head and the barge and Schooner in sight so ends this day

5 Tuesday this day a light breeze from the N the barge employed in boiling and the A. R. Tucker and Schooner came on board and got some of their oil so ends this day

6 Wednesday this day a light breeze from the S W the barge cruised under all sail employed in boiling and got through at 9 P.M. the Schooner and barge got their oil and went off and we got through stowing down 20 bl at noon so ends this day

7 Thursday this day we saw 2 blubber back and saw the A. R. Tucker whaleing the middle the barge standing to the E and the latter saw the A. R. Tucker cutting and she lost 3 boats and chased a large whale also the Schooner and our self but the whale gone quick to the S W so we came on board without success so ends this day

8 Friday this day a light breeze from the S the barge steering N. E. and raised a third whale at 6:30 P.M. and lost 2 boats at 7 P.M. but never saw them again the latter saw the Pedro with 3 whale a long side so ends this Broke out a barrel of keef.

9 Saturday this day light breeze from the south bark cruising under short sail with light rain and raised a school of whales at 10:30 A.M. And at 11:30 A.M. the L. B. struck and the W. B. struck same whale and got stove lightly also the mate the second mate shot the whale and the gun exploded and he got his fingers blown off. He cut his line and came aboard. Got the whale along side at 3 o'clock P.M. so ends this day

10 Sunday this day employed in cutting the body and later started boiling latter part finished cutting the whale. One sail in sight.

11 Monday this day employed in boiling and stowing down and latter part the same. Wind from W. Bark cruising under short sail. 2 sails in sight. Second Mate and the same so ends this day.
