

- 21 ^{June 1900} Thursday this day a light breeze from the S.W. the barque cruising under all sail and saw some drift stuff and a school of ⁴ ~~5~~ ^{grey} ~~blue~~ employed in breaking out water so ends this day the second mate hand a little better Lat 33.30 N Long 49.12 W
- 22 Friday this day a light breeze from the S.W. the barque cruising under all sail employed in ship's duty the Schooner in sight and the second mate hand a little better so ends this day Lat 33.40 Long 49.10
- 23 Saturday this day a light breeze from the S.W. the barque cruising under all sail employed in breaking out flour and doing other work the Schooner in sight so ends this day a little drift stuff around and the second mate hand a little better Lat 32.45 Long 49.09
- 24 Sunday this day a light breeze from the S.W. the barque cruising under all sail and spoke the Golden City and the Pedro Verieba and heard from other ships the second mate hand a little better so ends this day Lat Long
- 25 Monday this day commenced with a calm then a light breeze from the S.W. the barque cruising under all sail the two Schooners in sight and one Steamer we send letters by the Steamer so ends this day Lat 32.18 Long 49.27

- 26 Tuesday this day a calm the first and middle the latter a light breeze from the S.W. the barque cruising under all sail employed in breaking out Bread and Molasses and three sails and one Steamer in sight and the second mate hand are little better so ends this day Lat Long
- 27 Wednesday this day a light breeze from the S.W. the barque cruising under all sail employed in ship's duty and 3 sails in sight and the second mate hand a little better so ends this day the 2 Schooners was taken Lat 32.38 Long 50.13
- 28 Thursday this day a light breeze from the S.W. we saw 2 boats and chase with them but never got up to them and at dark saw something sparkling suppose to be whales but it was dark the middle and latter a light breeze from the S.W. the barque cruising the 2 Schooners in sight so ends this day Lat Long
- 29 Friday this day a light breeze from the S.W. the barque cruising under all sail employed in ship's duty and saw a dead whale and the 2 Schooners in sight the second mate hand a little better so ends this day Lat 32.18 Long 50.05
- 30 Saturday this day a light breeze from the S.W. the barque cruising under all sail also spoke the Golden City employed in ship's duty so ends this day Lat Long
