- 4 Thursday this day employed in taking the anchor from Gayol and then I under all sail and find two storm ways in the ship so ends this day
- 5 Friday this day employed in ship duty and the Island of Pico in sight the latter a light breeze from the S.E. the barque steering by the wind under all sail one Steamer in sight so ends this day
- 6 Saturday this day a light breeze from the S.W. the barque steering by the wind under all sail employed in ship duty, so ends this day
- 7 Sunday this day the Island of St. Mung in sight at dark the middle and latter a strong breeze from the S.W. the barque steering by the wind under all sail so ends this day
- 8 Monday this day a light breeze from the S.W. the barque steering by the wind and at dark saw the Schooner Pedro Varela the middle and latter the same employed in ship duty so ends this day

- 9 Tuesday this day a light breeze from the S.E. the barque steering by the wind under short sail employed in ship duty so ends this day
- 10 Wednesday this day a strong breeze from the S.E. the barque steering by the wind under short sail the latter the same employed in breaking out flour and doing other jobs so ends this day
- 11 Thursday this day a strong breeze from the S.W. the barque steering by the wind the middle and latter calm employed in breaking out Beef and Pork and doing other jobs so ends this day
- 12 Friday this day commenced with a light air from the N.W. the first part the middle and latter a light breeze from the N.E. the barque steering I under all sail employed in breaking out Bread gaze of cask 306 gallons and repairing the Gaff top sail so ends this day
- 13 Saturday this day a light breeze from the N.E. the barque steering I under all sail employed in repairing the Tug work and doing other jobs one sail in sight so ends this day
