I.B. all struck the L.B. and W.B. got close and chase of the G.B. and W.B.1, took the W.B. in one stroke and lost the whale the I.B. got the L.B. B.B.1 and commenced cutting so ends this day

- 5 Monday this day a light breeze from the E the barque laying two employed in cutting in and got through at 10.30 A.M. and commenced cutting up blubber so ends this day
