- 19 Wednesday this day commenced with a light breeze and foggy from the S.E. the first part the middle a strong breeze from the N.E. the latter we made a heavy squall from the S.W. and last 4 hours the barque laying too under guest wing main top sail and 2 staysails so ends this day and broke out 1 bbl Beef

- 20 Thursday this day commenced with a strong S.W. wind the middle the same the latter a light breeze from the S.E. the barque cruising under short sail the ship have leak all day but today we pump 1,000 strokes in 24 hours so ends

- 21 Friday this day a strong breeze from the S.W. and thick the middle and latter blowing a moderated gale from the S.W. the barque laying too nothing in sight so ends this day and we found the leak in the Starboard quarter we pump 1,000 strokes

- 22 Saturday this day a strong breeze from the S.W. the barque laying too and we pump 1,800 strokes the latter a light breeze we stop the leak we found the rope broke out employed in breaking out Rock and doing other jobs and ran 2 sails so ends this day

- Sunday this day a light breeze from the N.E. the barque cruising under short sail and raised a school of Whales at 1.30 P.M. and took 4 boats the W.B. struck a large whale and the S.B. boat 2 the B.B. the L.B. helped on the large whale the middle it blow strong and large sea running but we cut one small whale so ends this day we pump 130 strokes in 12 hours

- Monday this day a strong breeze from the S.W. the barque laying too employed in cutting up the large whale we cut the head off and let it go and save the body and started boiling at 11 P.M. the latter cut away from the tow small one they was burst and cutting up blubber so ends this day we pump 250 strokes in 12 hours

- Tuesday this day a light breeze from the S.W. the barque cruising under short sail employed in boiling and pumping water the latter boiling and storing oil and spoke the Butcher with 240 lbs so ends this day we pump 140 strokes in 12 hours

- Wednesday this day a light breeze from the N.E. the barque got through boiling at 9 P.M. the latter a light breeze from the N.E. the barque employed in storing oil and stow 2585 gallons and broke out flour and sugar and the Butcher in sight so ends this day we pump 150 strokes in 12 hours
