- 23 Wednesday this day a light breeze from the ~~the~~ barque cruising under short sail and got through boiling at 8 a M and stow down oil mutton 3.4 47 gallons and the Schooner in sight so ends this day we pump 280 strokes

- 24 Thursday this day a light breeze from the E.N.E. the barque cruising under all sail same grandeur employed in breaking out a new cask of Bread 297 gallons and a cask of Flour 166 gallons and repairs the cutting blocks and bend the old girth so ends this day we pump 280 strokes

- 25 Friday this day a light breeze the first and middle the latter blowing a gale from the S.E. and the E. so ends this day we pump 300 strokes

- 26 Saturday this day commenced with a gale from the E. the barque laying too under goose wing top sail the latter from the S.E. the barque laying the same so ends this day we pump 350 strokes

- 27 Sunday this day blowing a gale from the S.E. to the S.W. the barque laying too on the Starboard tack the middle and latter the same and carry away the BB burrow and ship a large sea one sail in sight so ends this day we pump 400 strokes in 24 hours

- 28 Monday this day blowing a moderate gale from the S and a heavy sea running the middle and latter a strong breeze from the S.E. the barque steering to the N.E. employed in breaking out 1 barrel of Pork and one sail in sight so ends this day we pump every 2 hour and pump 150 strokes

- 29 Tuesday this day commenced with a strong breeze from the S.E. the middle and latter the same employed in breaking out a new cask of Beef gauge of cask 158 and pumping every hour 60 strokes so ends this day

- 30 Wednesday this day a strong breeze and squally from the S.E. and light rain the middle and latter the same the barque carrying fore sail and main sail employed in ships duty and pump every hour and pump 60 to 70 strokes so ends this day

- 31 Thursday this day a strong breeze and rain from the S.E. to the S.W. the first part the middle and latter the barque steers E.S.E. under short sail same one sail and the pumping we quit the same so ends this day
