- 19 Tuesday this day a light breeze from the E & E the barque steering N.E. by N under all sail and raised a school of whales and saw 4 boats and got 8 whales along side and made them fast so ends this day

- 20 Wednesday this day a light breeze from the E the barque steering by the wind under short sail employed in cutting in 7th haler and wheat of in the night so ends this day 1 steamer

- 21 Thursday this day a very light air from the E & E the barque steering N.E. employed in cutting up blubber and clean the heads and started boiling at 3 P.M. the middle and latter came and boiling and setting up coals and pumping water so ends this day

- 22 Friday this day a light breeze from the E the barque steering N.E. by N under all sail employed in breaking out Beef and Bread and got through boiling at 1.30 P.M. and got through stowing down 2081 gallons and 3 Steams and 2 sails in sight so ends this day

- 23 Saturday this day a strong breeze from the E & E the barque steering N.E. by N half N under all sail employed in washing ship and doing other jobs and one steamer and 1 sail in sight so ends this day

- 24 Sunday this day a light breeze from the E & E the barque steering N.N.W. the first part the middle day a back the latter Steams N.N.E. and raised the Island of Rocas at 10 P.M. and sent 2 boats fishing so ends this day
