- 16 Tuesday this day employed in painting ship and taking water and the Captain have not return from Rover so ends this day and broke out 1 barrel of Beef
- 17 Wednesday this day employed in ships duty that is doing odd jobs so ends this day and open 1 Pork and the Captain return from Rover
- 18 Thursday this day employed in taking water and breading and open 1 blt Pork
- 19 Friday this day employed in taking wood and doing other job so ends this day
- 20 Saturday this day employed in breading and open a new cask of Beef and 1 barrel of pork so ends this day so ends this day and the Ellen A Swift sail
- 21 Sunday this day one watch on shore so ends this day
- 22 Monday this day sent the Platina with 50 blt white paint and 20 blt black paint and the Pedro Vazela came to anchor at Dominica with 430 blt this season so ends this day
- 23 Tuesday this day employed in taking the Am Che from Dominica Platina and Pearl Nelson and the Pedro Vazela had 10 gallons of Paint oil and crate of Quins and we all started out together and broke out 1 barrel of Beef so ends this day

- 24 Wednesday this day a light breeze from the N.E. the tugging of Eustatia and the copper and three seamen and the Planting and Pearl Nelson pass so ends this day and 2 men sick

- 25 Thursday this day a light breeze from the N.E. the barkue steering N by W under all sail employed in breaking out 1 barrel of Pork and bread the new main sail and doing other jobs so ends this day and open a new cask of Flour 201 galls 3 men sick Tot 19.25

- 26 Friday this day a light breeze from the S the barkue steering N half W under all sail employed in bending the fore sail and doing other jobs and one Steamer in sight so ends this day 3 men sick
