26 Sunday this day all hands on shore so ends this day

27 Monday this day employed in taking the Archer from Bermuda at 8 a.m. and the Fichonia Ellen A. Swift and E. B. Connell and we took the tug to get out so ends this day

28 Tuesday this day employed in beating out and got a shore on the reef and we had to take a tag and be us out the middle and with the barque star E under short sail we had the wind from the S one sail in sight employed in ships duty so ends this day and Anton Corbello as boat-tender and found one stove away Lat 32 42 Long 61 28

29 Wednesday this day a light breeze from the S the barque steering E under all sail and saw the Ellen A. Swift cutting a small whale and the E. B. Connell in sight employed in painting the B.B. and doing other jobs so ends this day
