- 3 Tuesday this day a strong breeze and heavy rain from the S.W. the barque laying off and on Flores and the Captain came on board and the boat or came on board and started for Fajal under all sail and a very light breeze so ends this day
- 4 Wednesday this day a light breeze from the N.W. the barque steering S.E. by E half S under all sail employed in scraping down painting the brake so ends this day
- 5 Thursday this day a light breeze from the N.W. the barque steering S.E. by E under all sail and raised Fajal at 1 P.M. and at dark the land was E by S about 10 miles at dark the latter the Captain went on shore for letters and find the Packet there so ends this day
- 6 Friday this day a light breeze from the N.W. the Captain came on board and started of St. George to cruise the latter a strong breeze and rainey from the N.W. the Island in sight so ends this day
- 7 Saturday this day blowing a gale from the N.W. the barque is trying to under short sail with Terceira about 10 miles off so ends this day and upon a new cask of Flour

- 8 Sunday this day a strong breeze from the N.W. the barque laying to under short sail and the Island of Terceira in sight so ends this day
- 9 Monday day a strong breeze from the N.W. the first and middle the latter a light breeze from the S.W. the barque steering by the wind under all sail employed in breaking out a cask of Pork so ends this day
- 10 Tuesday this day a light breeze from the S.W. and at dark the Island of Terceira about 10 miles the middle and latter blowing a heavy gale from the S and lost the S.B. and on davit so ends this day
- 11 Wednesday this day blowing a gale from the S and at dark it moderated the middle it strong breeze the latter a light breeze from the N.W. the barque steering S under all sail employed in mending ship so ends this day
- 12 Thursday this day a light breeze from the N.E. the barque steering S.W. and ran Graciosa at 6 P.M. and got up the cable and came to anchor at Fajal at 4 A.M. so ends this day and took 2 barrels of Beef from the Brig
- 13 Friday this day employed in mending the yards and spars and took the foremast from the brig so ends this day
- 14 Saturday employed in taking the foremast out and doing other jobs so ends this day
