- 24 Sunday this day came the first and middle the latter a light breeze and light passing rain squalls from the S. the barque steering by the wind under short sail one sail in sight so ends this day

- 25 Monday this day a light breeze and light passing rain squalls from the N.E. the barque laying too under short sail the first and middle the latter made all sail and steer W one sail in sight so ends this day
