13 Friday this day a strong breeze from the S the barque steering by the wind under short sail and raised a large Spanish Whale at 6.30 A.M. and had 3 barrels at 8 A.M. and at 5.20 the G. B. struck and got him a large side at 10 A.M. and got ready to cut and got dinner so ends this day and one Steam in sight

14 Saturday this day employed in cutting and got the Body in and led the head out side and started boiling at 7.30 P.M. the middle blowing strong the latter the same with a heavy sea from the S the barque luying too with the head along side but still boiling so ends this day
