19 Thursday this day a strong breeze from the N.E. the barque steaming W.S. under short sail and raised a school of whales at 6 AM and towed 3 boats at 10.30 AM and at 10.50 the L.B. struck and got him along side at noon so ends this day

20 Friday this day a strong breeze from the N.E. employed in cutting in the small whale and got through at 2 PM and made sail and chase the school and towed 3 boats and the L.B. struck a large whale and got him along side at dark and started boiling the small one the middle and latter blowing a moderated gale from the N.E. so we could not cut in and got through boiling at noon so ends this day

21 Saturday this day blowing strong and a heavy sea but we cut in the body of the large whale and started boiling the middle and latter blowing strong from the N. the barque lying so employed in boiling but slow so ends this day

22 Sunday this day a light breeze from the E.N.E. employed in tacking the head and boiling and stowing a little oil and one Steamer in sight so ends this day the men had Molasses
