- 6 Sunday this day a light breeze from the E the barge steering for Dominico employed in setting up cask and hauling the chane and got the Anchor of the barge and came to Anchor at 8 A.M. and the W. A. George was laying off and on so ends this day
- 7 Monday this day employed in taking water and breaking out the hold and washing ship so ends this day
- 8 Tuesday this day employed in taking water and doing other jobs so ends this day
- 9 Wednesday this day rainy employed in taking water and wood so ends this day and open a cask of Flour
- 10 Thursday this day taking wood and stowing the hold also took the Anchor from Dominico and made all sail and steer for Gustavus so ends this day
- 11 Friday this day a light breeze from the N.E. the barge steering N.N.W. under all sail and came to Anchor at Gustavus at 6.30 P.M. so ends this day
- 12 Saturday employed painting ship and rainy weather so ends this day
- 13 Sunday this day all hands on shore so ends this day
- 14 Monday this day employed in painting ship so ends this day
- 15 Tuesday this day employed in painting and got through so ends this day

- 16 Wednesday this day employed in taking Potatoes and yams and 3 boats for a Steamship and the L. B. struck and got the whale along side at 8 P.M. so ends this day
- 17 Thursday this day employed in cutting in and started boiling at noon and the decks was full of people from shore and got the ough at 3 A.M. so ends this day
- 18 Friday this day getting ready to take the Anchor and took it at 5 P.M. but it was calm so ends this day and ship five seamen
- 19 Saturday this day a light breeze from the S.E. the barge steering N.E. under all sail employed in stowing down oil and stove 589 gallons of Steamship oil so ends this day and broke out barrel of Pork
