 the S.W. and S the breeze steering N.W. under all  
 sail and ~~sailed~~ Gay Head at noon and some  
 land sea Steamers and barges and fish boat  
 and Schooners seen this day

30 Wednesday this day commenced with a  
 calm and we are lying between Sore and Big  
 light ship and the main land with thick  
 fog the first and middle and latter it  
 blew away and we anchor at midnight  
 and took the anchor at 6 A.M. and  
 beat in the channel with a thick  
 fog so ends this day

31 Thursday this day a light breeze  
 from the E the breeze beating in the  
 channel and at 3 P.M. the tug took  
 us in tow so ends this day and this
