Sunday 21

This day begun with light breeze bark with boats down chasing whales came on board at 8th hour without success. at 6th hour saw another large sperm whale lowered three boats but without success. Latter part light Breeze and hazy weather at 15th hour raised a large sperm whale and lowered for him later on saw ~~two~~ more large whales and a school of sperm whales. The starboard boat got a large one and the Bow Boat struck two but line parted both times.
