First part of this day strong breeze at 4:30 o'clock raised a school of large sperm whales lowered three boats the L. B. struck one but iron came out. Also lost the the head of the other whale the chain parted.

Latter part strong breeze saw whales again at 11th hour lowered and the W. B. got fast on a large one but took his line B. B. and L. B. got fast on same whale which took the L. B. down and the Bow Boat out to pick up the mate latter on got fast again but whale took all the lances and bombs that were in the boats and would not die.
