Whales 5

First part of this day light winds, picked up 3 whales which boats had and made them fast. Latter part cut in the whales and saw another school of whales and got ready to lower for them.

First part of this day light winds boats down after whales and got five also boiling. Latter part cutting in boiling and stowing oil land in sight. Had some rain.
