1904. May. 1904.

Sunday<sup>1</sup> These twenty four hours all hands on shore.

Monday<sup>2</sup> This day hauled back alongside the three masted schooner & landed 15 casks of oil on board and took all our stuff dropped off again and started to set up casks.

Tuesday<sup>3</sup> Employed these 24 hours in setting up schooner and tagging casks.

Wednesday<sup>4</sup> Employed these 24 hours in setting up casks.

Thursday<sup>5</sup> Employed in Discharging the rest of the oil.

Friday<sup>6</sup> Employed in stowing hold and rafting water.

Saturday<sup>7</sup> Employed in stowing hold and setting up casks and rafting water.

Sunday<sup>8</sup> Employed in nothing watch on shore.
