Monday 9

Got through taking water and storing hold and food and at 4 P.M. got under weigh and started for St. Kitts. Latter part Montserrat in sight. While drawing water to fill wing casks and to wash ship with one sailor Jose Rofino Fortes fell overboard and was drowned we lowered the boat for him as quickly as possible but as he did not know how to swim a stroke he quickly went down and was seen only once afterwards. Time was 6 P.M.

Tuesday 10

First part of this day dropped anchor at St. Kitts. Latter part took the Captain's wife on board and got under way again bound for St. Eustatius.

Wednesday 11

First part of this day dropped anchor and rolled over boats got them ready to paint and fill wing casks with salt water. Latter part employed in painting boats.

Thursday 12

This day employed in painting boats and taking potatoes and yams.

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Friday 13

Finished taking yams & potatoes and latter part got under way.

Saturday 14

First part of this day light N.E. trades bark steering by the wind St. Martin in sight. Latter part same winds Sombro in sight.

First part of this day light E. winds bark steering by the wind heading N.E. by N. Latter part had thunder and rain squalls and light winds.

First part of this day light winds from E. freshening to a stiff breeze bark going by the wind one sail in sight. Latter part fresh trades did some breaking out on the two decks. opened a cask of bread.
