This day began with strong trade winds and rough seas. bark cruising under upper topsails. broke out sugar, coffee and beans. Latter wind moderated bark cruising under all sail saw porpoises and squid. Also saw on white water but did not come to anything.

This day began with calm weather and very hot. Latter part light winds and fine weather broke out one cask of beef and filled scuttle butts with water.
