Wednesday 26

This day began with light winds and fine weather bark steering W. all sail out at 2 P. M. sighted the Barbadoes. and hauled up chains. And dropped anchor at 6 P. M. Laying to anchor all of latter part and washed vessel outside.

Thursday 27

This day laying to anchor and took in some molasses and sugar and mate took his discharge got under way at 5 P. M. and started for Dominica. Latter part Martinique in sight. Employed in stowing away a few things.

Friday 28

This day began with fresh winds and hazy weather bark steering S. W. all sail out Dominica in sight. Latter part anchored in Dominica and started to break out oil in after hold.

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Saturday 29

This day finished breaking out after hold and stowed back.

Sunday 30

This day all hands on shore and nothing doing.
