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- Friday⁹ This day fresh trades and smoky weather. Took steering S.W. by N. Dill sail out Dominica and Martinique in sight.
- Saturday¹⁰ This day light trades and fine weather. Dropped anchor in Prince Rupert's Bay.
- Sunday¹¹ Fine weather and every thing quite.
- Monday¹² Got some water and washed vessel got ready to paint.
- Tuesday¹³ Started painting vessel inside.
- Wednesday¹⁴ Employed these 24 hours in painting spars.
- Thursday¹⁵ Employed these 24 hours in painting spars.
- Friday¹⁶ Still painting spars and other things.
- Saturday¹⁷ Got some water and did other things.
