Employed in doing nick-nacks, one watch on shore.

Wednesday⁴

Employed this day in doing a little painting one watch on shore.

Thursday⁵

Employed this day in doing various small jobs, one watch on shore.

Friday⁶

Employed in doing odd jobson rigging one watch on shore three masted schooner Frederick Rosemer arrived with provisions. Capt. J. P. Edwards. came to take charge of Greyhound.

Saturday⁷

Employed this day in taking empty casks ashore from three masted.

Sunday⁸

Nothing doing one watch on shore all day.

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Monday⁹

This day employed in breaking out oil and towing empty casks ashore from the schooner.

Tuesday¹⁰

This day employed in breaking out oil, also hauled bark alongside of schooner.

Wednesday¹¹

Employed in giving schooner oil and breaking out.

Thursday¹²

This day employed in breaking out and giving schooner oil.

Friday¹³

Employed in getting some water got through giving oil took provisions on board and left schooner and dropped our anchor.

Saturday¹⁴

Employed in stowing and getting water.

Sunday¹⁵

Nothing doing one watch on shore.

Monday¹⁶

Employed this day in stowing hold, getting water and sending down sails from foremast getting ready to send up new fore top mast.

Tuesday¹⁷

Employed in rafting water and stowing Captain went to Roseau

Wednesday¹⁸

Employed in rafting water and stowing Captain came from Roseau
