This day employed in rafting water and stowing. Also sent down old fore topmast and sent up new one.

Friday 20

This day employed in rafting water and stowing and got through. Also finished getting good and working on fore mast.

Saturday 21

Employed in getting ready for sea and sailed at 3 P. M. for St. Kitts. at midnight struck calm abreast of Guadalupe and had no more wind for rest of day.

Sunday 22

This day day begun with calm at 5 P. M. Got light S. E. winds and at 6 A. M. dropped anchor at St. Kitts and got some potatoes.

Monday 23

Got under way at 3 P. M. for St. Eustatius and dropped anchor at 9 A. P. M. in the morning started working on the try works to put in a new pot.

Tuesday 24

Employed in working on try works and doing other small jobs.

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Wednesday 25

Employed in doing various jobs on rigging and masons working on try works.

Thursday 26

Crew employed in filling wing casks with salt water and masons finished try works.

Friday 27

Getting ready for sea and sailed at 9 A. M.

Saturday 28

Light N. E. winds bark steering by the wind heading for Sombred Passage. Passed it at midnight morning fresh wind.

Sunday 29

This day began with fresh N. E. trade winds bark steering by the wind all sail out. latter part same. one sail in sight.

Monday 30

The whole of the 24 hours had fresh N. E. winds and fine weather bark steering by the wind on starboard tack. Employed in doing ~~various things~~ various things.
